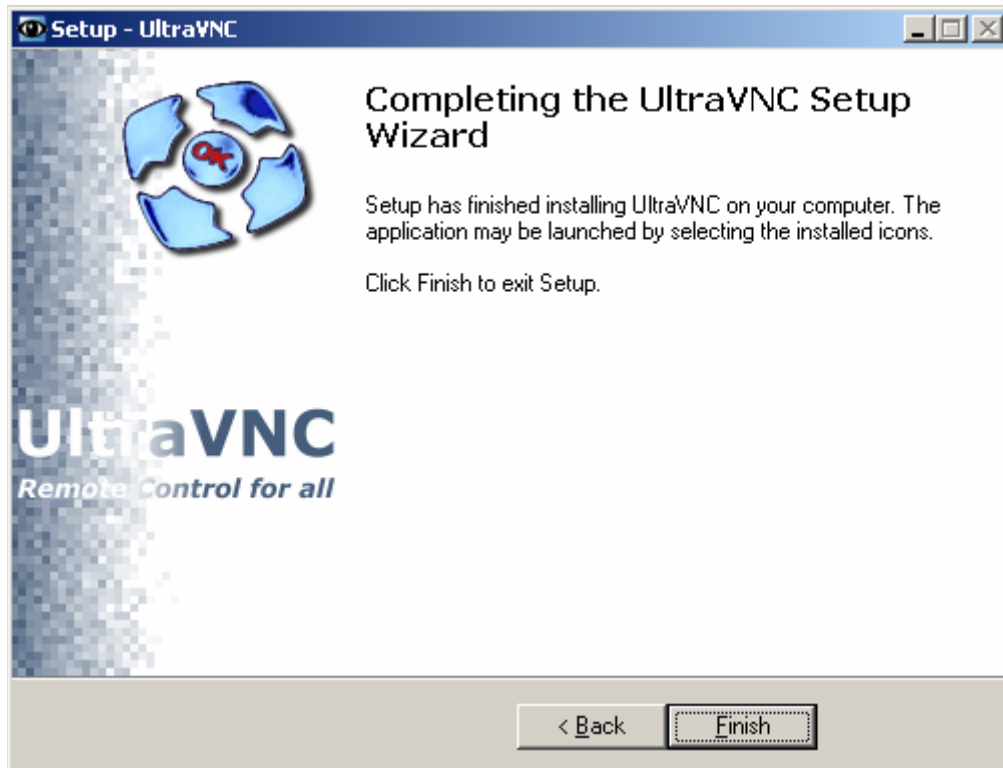
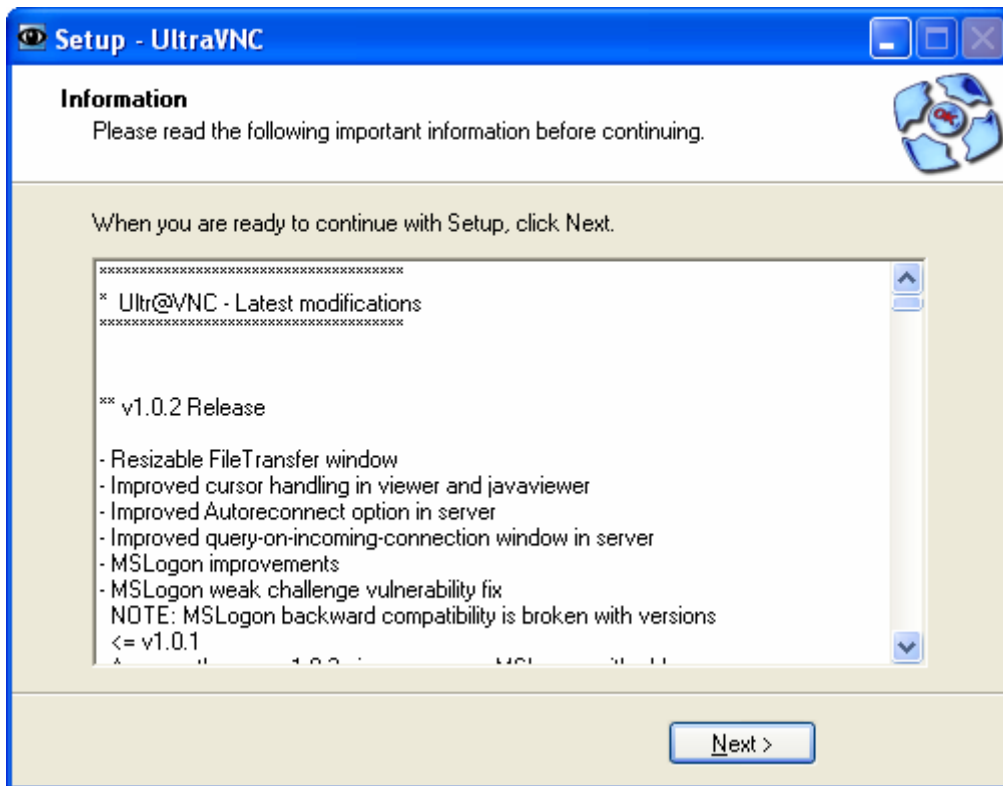




Where VNC password is highlighted above enter steveg or whatever password directed. When the password is typed in it may be masked by dots or vertical bars.
